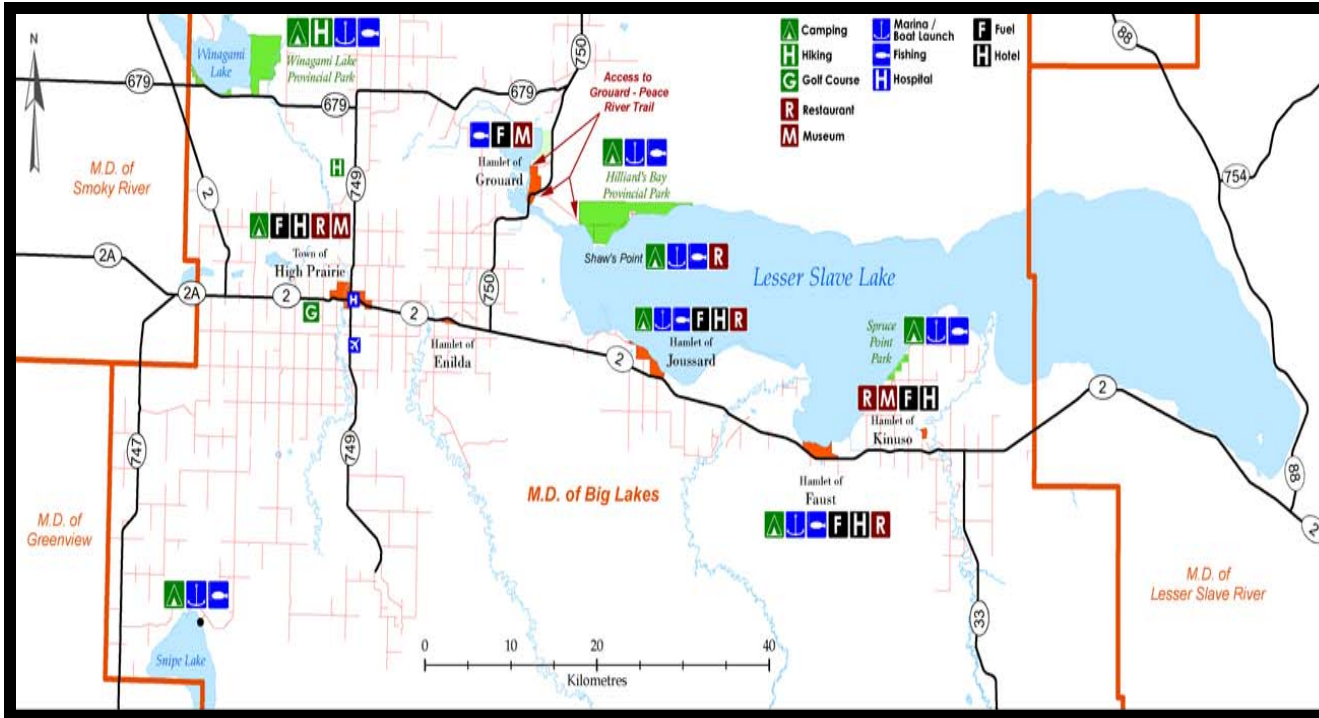


Explore Northern Alberta...find us here!



The southern boundary of the Municipal District of Big Lakes is less than 3 hours north of Edmonton near the Town of Swan Hills and stretches north and west beyond the western end of Lesser Slave Lake and the Town of High Prairie. Much of the population is located along the southern and western shores of the lake in one of five hamlets. In addition, visitors can enjoy the natural attractions and facilities at other lakes in the region, including Snipe, Winagami, and Utikuma.

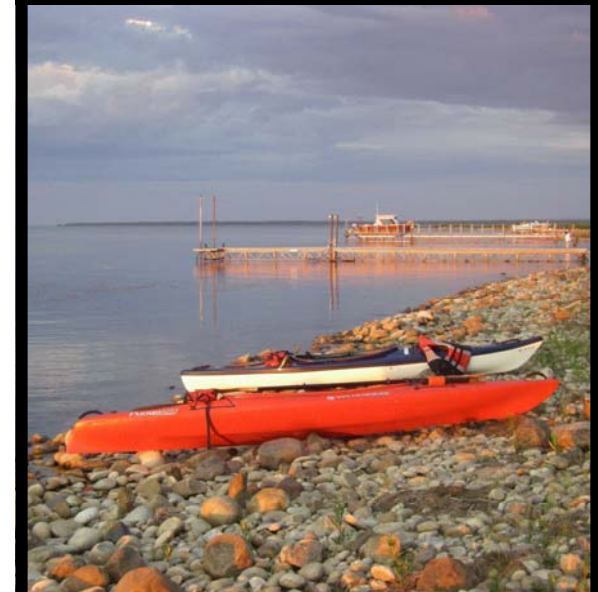
